Subject: State Ethics Law

Debra :

As a follow up to our telephone call, attached please find a copy of SB 948. This bill was introduced last year, but failed to pass. The language in the bill arose out of meetings with Sen. Raskin, MML, MACO and the State Ethics Commission. Sen. Raskin's staff has indicated that they would like to use this bill as a starting point for this year's legislation. The group of municipalities that we are working with supports the language in this bill that is applicable to municipalities. We intend to request of Sen. Raskin that Counties and Boards of Education be removed from this year's legislation in order for there to be a better chance of passage.

I will follow up with you after our meetings on Thursday with Sen. Raskin and Del. Robinson.
