

Resolution No. 6-91

RESOLUTION: To create a Civic Center
Mansion Subcommittee

WHEREAS, following a public hearing and further discussions regarding a proposal to designate the Rockville Civic Center Mansion and surrounding grounds as an Historic District, it was determined that a subcommittee be formed to provide guidance in preserving the historic integrity, aesthetic appeal and economic utility of the Rockville Civic Center Mansion and surrounding grounds; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation and Park Advisory Board, the Cultural Arts Commission, the Historic District Commission and the Civic Center Mansion Docents have agreed to the formation of a subcommittee under the aegis of the Recreation and Park Advisory Board for the purpose of overseeing implementation of the Rockville Civic Center Mansion Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, that:

1. There is hereby created a Civic Center Mansion Subcommittee of the Recreation and Park Advisory Board to be comprised of staff representatives and five voting members as follows: two representatives of the Recreation and Park Advisory Board; one representative of the Cultural Arts Commission; one representative from the Historic District Commission; and one Civic Center Mansion Docent. Each group shall appoint its own representatives to the Subcommittee.

2. The Subcommittee shall oversee the implementation of the Rockville Civic Center Mansion Master Plan.

3. The Subcommittee shall report to the Recreation and Park Advisory Board.


4. The Recreation and Park Advisory Board shall maintain primary responsibility for the Civic Center Mansion Complex, and the Cultural Arts Commission shall maintain its program responsibilities for the Mansion.

5. Changes to the exterior of the Civic Center Mansion and the immediate surrounding grounds, including the formal gardens, shall be referred to the Historic District Commission for their review and input to the Subcommittee.

6. A review of the Mansion's status as it pertains to Historic District designation will be made two years from the date of this Resolution.
