

Resolution No. ____ Resolution: To approve amendments to the Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Regulations prepared by the Department of Public Works pursuant to Chapter 19 of the Rockville City Code

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Rockville had previously adopted Resolution No. 3-86 approving Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Regulations established by the City's Department of Public Works pursuant to Chapter 19 entitled "Sediment Control and Stormwater Management" to the Rockville City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council adopted Resolution Nos. 5-91, 15-02, 5-08 and 7-10 amending said "Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Regulations" and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. -12, adopted December 17, 2012, Chapter 19 of the Rockville City Code has been amended so as to comply the Requirements of the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 26.17.01 and the 2011 Maryland Standards and Specifications by requiring consideration of sediment control measures at the earliest stages in the planning process; and integrating sediment control and stormwater management measures into the development program.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to modify the City's Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Regulations adopted by Resolution Nos. 3-86 and amended by Resolution Nos. 5-91, 15-02, 5-08 and 7-10 to conform them to Chapter 19 of the Rockville City Code, as amended , and to make other appropriate modifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, that pursuant to Section 19-5 of the Rockville City Code, the attached

document entitled “City of Rockville Department of Public Works Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Regulations” dated December 17, 2012, is hereby approved and said regulations shall supersede regulations previously approved by Resolutions Nos. 3-86 and modified by Resolutions No. 5-91, 15-02, 5-08, and 7-10.
