ORDINANCE:

To amend Chapter 15 of the Rockville City Code entitled "Personnel" by amending Article IV. "Employee Discipline, Division 3. "Personnel Appeals Board," Section 15-61, "Composition," and Article VI. "Retirement Plan", Division 2. Retirement Board," Section 15-83 "Members" so as to modify the length of terms of appointment for the members of the Personnel Appeals Board and Retirement Board

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF ROCKVILLE, that Chapter 15 of the Rockville City Code entitled "Personnel," Division 3. "Personnel Appeals Board," be amended as follows:

**CHAPTER 15. PERSONNEL**

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**ARTICLE IV. EMPLOYEE DISCIPLINE**

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**Division 3. Personnel Appeals Board**

**Sec. 15-61. Composition.**

(a) The Council shall appoint a Personnel Appeals Board of three (3) persons for the purpose of hearing appeals by employees from disciplinary dismissals. Membership upon the Board shall be restricted to qualified voters of the City who are not City employees and who are not officials of the City. Appointments shall be for terms of [four (4)] three (3) years years.

(b) The Mayor shall designate a Chairman for the Board.

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ARTICLE VI. RETIREMENT PLAN

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Division 2. Retirement Board

Sec. 15-82. Created.

There is hereby created a City Retirement Board.

Sec. 15-83. Members.

(a) The Retirement Board shall consist of seven (7) members, as follows, all of whom, except the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council:

- (1) The City Manager or his designee;
- (2) A member of the Council;
- (3) Three (3) City employees, who shall be below the level of assistant department director, to be elected by City employees in accordance with such procedures as may from time to time be established by the City Manager.
- (4) Two (2) persons with financial or administrative business experience. No employee of an institution which is trustee for any funds of the retirement plan shall be eligible for appointment.

(b) Each member of the Board shall upon appointment take an oath of office that he will diligently and honestly administer the affairs of the Board. The oath shall be subscribed by the maker thereof. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee shall be a permanent appointee to the Board. The Councilmember designee shall be a permanent appointment to the Board. The Councilmember shall be appointed to serve for a term concurrent with the Councilmember's term of office. The remaining members shall serve for [two (2)] three (3) year terms, and until their successors have been appointed, confirmed and qualified.
