

## **Incorporation of Works of Art In Public Architecture (AIPA) Ordinance (1%)**

The purpose of the "Incorporation of Works of Art in Public Architecture" (AIPA) ordinance is to promote the quality of life for the residents by requiring the incorporation of works of art in public architecture. The ordinance requires that an amount equal to one percent of the City's costs for capital projects involving the construction of, or major improvements to, buildings, parks and other public structure be reserved for the procurement and installation of permanent artwork.

**AIPA artworks may include, but are not limited to:** paintings, sculptures, engravings, carvings, frescoes, mobiles, murals, collages, mosaics, statues, bas-reliefs, tapestries, photographs, drawings, stained glass, fountains, or other artworks for exterior and interior sites.

**Not to include:** fixtures or features such as landscaping, gates, streetlights, benches, signs, or other design elements unless designed by an artist as a "unique feature".

**Funding Source:** One percent of the City's costs for capital projects (CIP) involving the construction or major renovations is funded in the Art in Public Architecture Special Activities Fund for site-specific artwork related to the project.

**Note:** The City Manager shall make determination as to the applicability and/or implementation of this ordinance to the specific CIP projects. Project recommended for the 1% allocation are noted in the City Manager's budget (CIP).

### **Examples of AIPA Projects Awarded:**

Croydon Creek Nature Center mosaic relief, Memorial Day Parade acrylics and oils mural in City Hall, F. Scott Fitzgerald Theater painted steel mobile, aluminum kinetic sculpture for Rockville Senior Center, hand painted quilts and acoustic baffles in the Rockville Swim and Fitness Center, and historical Photographs in the Pump House.
