





Dear Neighborhood Leaders:

The Department of Community Planning and Development Services has asked me to forward the following information regarding a text amendment that proposes to change the City Zoning Ordinance to increase the amount that a covered porch can encroach into a front or rear yard setback area. We would greatly appreciate it if you could share this information with your community members via your listserve, newsletters and by word of mouth.

Thanks in advance for your assistance in the matter.

On March 17, the Mayor and Council filed a text amendment (TXT2008-00220) which proposes to change the City Zoning Ordinance to increase the amount that a covered porch can encroach into a front or rear yard setback area. The City's Board of Appeals recommended this change to encourage community building that comes from neighbors interacting in outdoor spaces. The Board noted:

"It is believed that if people use their front porches as a living space, they will be more likely to strike up a casual conversation with neighbors walking past their homes. Also,

by having large front porches, streets appear narrower leading to reduced driving speeds through a neighborhood."

The Representatives of Rockville's Zoning Ordinance Review (RORZOR) also discussed this topic. RORZOR recommended, and the text amendment proposes, that porches be allowed to extend 12 feet into both the front and rear yard setbacks. The current law only permits a covered porch to extend 3 feet into the setback areas and allows uncovered steps, stoops or porches to extend 9 feet into the front or rear setbacks. In sum, the policy of the City has moved towards permitting porches to extend further into the yard than is currently allowed without obtaining a variance. The proposed text amendment would enable this to occur.
